Affected Facility	City of Vancouver – Westside Water Reclamation Facility 2323 West Mill Plain Boulevard Vancouver, WA 98660
Description of Facility	The facility treats municipal wastewater from the City of Vancouver and surrounding areas. The treatment process includes the operation of an odor control scrubber and a sewage sludge incinerator (SSI).
Source Designation	<u>Title V</u> The facility is a stationary source subject to the Operating Permit Program contained in Chapter 173-401 WAC and is required to obtain a Title V Air Operating Permit. The facility is subject to Title V under Section 129 of the Federal Clean Air Act and emissions are below major thresholds of 100 tpy of any single criteria pollutant, 10 tpy of any single hazardous air pollutant, and 25 tpy of any combination of hazardous air pollutants.
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application for installation of a mercury control scrubber for the SSI in order to comply with requirements under the SSI Federal Plan; this Plan is expected to be promulgated in 2016. The application has not yet been reviewed to determine if it is administratively complete. The SWCAA permit writer identified below will be reviewing the application to make a determination of completeness and, if necessary, make a request for additional information. A copy of the application will be available to the public when the application is determined to be complete.
Affected Pollutants	The proposed permitting action is expected to impact emissions of the following pollutants: Nitrogen Oxides, Carbon Monoxide, Particulate Matter, Volatile Organic Compounds, Sulfur Dioxide, and Toxic and/or Hazardous Air Pollutants
Public Comment Period	A 30 day public comment period on the draft permit will be provided for this application pursuant to SWCAA 400-171(3). When complete, a copy of the draft permit will be made available at the SWCAA business office and posted on the SWCAA webpage under the "Permits and Appeals/Open for Public Comment" section at http://www.swcleanair.org/permitprelims.asp . A notice announcing the draft permit will be published in a local newspaper.

A public hearing will be held if the Control Officer determines that significant public interest exists.
