Affected Facility	City of Vancouver - Marine Park Wastewater Treatment Facility 4650 SE Columbia Way Vancouver, WA 98661
Description of Facility	This facility is a municipal wastewater treatment plant operating an odor control scrubber. The facility also has several emergency engines located at the facility and at three pump stations in Vancouver.
Source Designation	<u>Natural Minor</u> The facility is a stationary source subject to review under SWCAA 400-110. Facility emissions are less than 100 tons per year (tpy) of any single criteria pollutant, less than 10 tpy of any single hazardous air pollutant, and less than 25 tpy of any combination of hazardous air pollutants.
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application to modify the visible emission (opacity) limits to the emergency engines. The application has not yet been reviewed to determine if it is administratively complete. The SWCAA permit writer identified below will be reviewing the application to determine completeness and, if necessary, make a request for additional information. A copy of the application will be available to the public when the application is determined to be complete.
Affected Pollutants	The proposed permitting action is expected to impact emissions of the following pollutants: <i>Nitrogen Oxides, Carbon Monoxide, Particulate Matter, Volatile Organic Compounds</i>
Public Comment Period	No public comment period for the draft permit is currently scheduled. A 30-day public comment period for the draft permit may be provided upon written request pursuant to SWCAA 400-171(3).

A public hearing will be held if the Executive Director determines that significant public interest exists.
