Affected Facility	Port of Longview 10 Port Way, Longview, Washington 98632
Description of Facility	The Port of Longview operates a marine terminal and bulk product handling facility. The Port has eight designated berths and multiple storage buildings used for loading or unloading of bulk materials and logs to and from ocean-going ships, railcars and trucks.
Source Designation	Title V Opt-out. This facility is a stationary source that would be subject to the Operating Permit Program if a federally enforceable emission limit was not in place. Facility emissions are limited to less than 100 tpy of any single criteria pollutant, less than 10 tpy of any single hazardous air pollutant, and less than 25 tpy of any combination of hazardous air pollutants.
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application for modification of existing bulk material handling equipment, relocation of an existing dust collector, and installation of two new dust collectors at the above described facility. The application has not yet been reviewed to determine if it is administratively complete. The SWCAA permit writer identified below will be reviewing the application to make a determination of completeness and, if necessary, make a request for additional information. A copy of the application will be available to the public when the application is determined to be complete.
Affected Pollutants	The proposed permitting action is expected to impact emissions of the following pollutants: PM, HAPs, TAPs
