PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice to the public is hereby given that the Southwest Clean Air Agency (SWCAA) has made a preliminary determination to issue Air Discharge Permit SWCAA 14-3087R1 to CCP Composites. This preliminary determination allows for the increase in VOC and HAP emission limits and the introduction of new raw materials and additional mixers at the facility at 3712 North Park Drive, Centralia, Lewis County, Washington. The new facility is a potential source of NOX and CO from the combustion of natural gas, and VOCs and HAPs from the manufacturing of gel coat.

The public has an opportunity to review and comment on the preliminary Air Discharge Permit. All written or oral comments must be received by SWCAA within 30 days after the date of publication. Final action by SWCAA to approve, modify, or deny the proposal will be taken within 10 days after the close of the comment period. If there is a demonstrated significant public interest, a public meeting may be held at the close of the public comment period.
