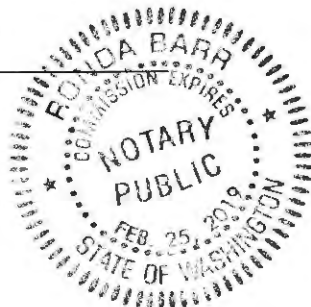

Notice to the public is hereby given that the Southwest Clean Air Agency (SWCAA) is providing a thirty (30) day public comment period for the preliminary determination to issue Air Discharge Permit 17-3248 to Sierra Pacific Industries. The preliminary determination approves the increase in dry kiln temperatures. No new processes are proposed.

Copies of the preliminary ADP and associated Technical Support Document are available for review at 11815 NE 99th Street, Suite 1294, Vancouver, Washington, Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Electronic copies are available for review in the permit section of SWCAA's internet website (<http://www.swcleanair.org/PermitsPrelim.html>). This material will be made available in other media, if necessary. All written or oral comments must be received by SWCAA within thirty (30) days after this publication. Final action by SWCAA to approve, modify, or deny the proposal will be taken within ten (10) days after the close of the comment period. If there is a demonstrated significant public interest, a public hearing may be held during the thirty-day comment period.
