DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 17-043**

Description of proposal:

ADP Application CL-3010: The proponent has applied for a permit to install additional woody debris processing equipment driven by diesel engines. The equipment will be a source of combustion emissions. At the emission levels proposed, this equipment will not have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality.
