**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 18-001**

**Description of proposal:**

ADP Application CL-3027: The proponent has applied for a permit to install and operate a facility to load propane into tank trucks from railcars using compressors driven by diesel engines. There is the potential for leaks of propane from valves, pumps, and fittings. In addition, the diesel engines will be a source of noise and combustion emissions. At the emission levels proposed, the new equipment will not have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality. Based on the size of the engines and their location (in an industrial area), noise is not expected to have a significant adverse impact. This permitting action is not expected to have a significant adverse impact on traffic, glare, housing, or recreation opportunities.
