DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 18-005

Description of proposal:

ADP Application CL-3034: Proponent proposes to add four pieces of portable, diesel engine powered equipment (crusher, screens, stacking conveyor) to an existing aggregate processing facility. Overall facility throughput will remain the same. Addition of the new equipment will not change the nature of existing operations, and is consistent with existing land zoning. Impact on all media other than air is expected to be the same as existing operations. Impact on air will be minimized through the use of best management practices and wet suppression systems. Facility operations are being conducted in accordance with a Surface Mining Reclamation Permit issued by the Washington Department of Natural Resources (Permit No. 70-010403).
