Description of Facility	Industrial and Municipal Waste Landfill
Source Designation	<u>Title V</u> The facility is a stationary source subject to the Operating Permit Program contained in Chapter 173-401 WAC. Facility emissions will be less than the major source threshold; however the facility will be subject to the operating permit program because it is an "affected source" under 40 CFR 60 Subpart WWW "Standards of Performance for Municipal Solid Waste Landfills" and the facility has a design capacity of greater than 2.5 million megagrams and 2.5 million cubic meters.
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application for modification of emission limits to account for higher than expected landfill gas flow and H <sub>2</sub> S concentrations. The application has not yet been reviewed to determine if it is administratively complete. The SWCAA permit writer identified below will be reviewing the application to make a determination of completeness and, if necessary, make a request for additional information.
Affected Pollutants	The proposed permitting action is expected to impact emissions of the following pollutants:  NO <sub>x</sub> , CO, VOC, SO <sub>2</sub> , PM, HAP, TAP
Public Comment Period	A 30 day public comment period will be provided for this application/permit pursuant to SWCAA 400-171(3). A notice announcing the draft permit will be published in a local newspaper.
